With a population of 5 500 inhabitants, Tynset is a regional centre of Nord-Østerdalen, in the county of Hedmark in inland Norway.

The primary industries are still an important part of commercial life, but the public sector and service industries within the fields of trade, computing, law, finance, building and construction, are predominant. In addition Tynset have good municipal services. We provide kindergarden for all children, and we offer services to many users in the health sector.

A college department of decentralized education and a hospital is located here as well.

Tynset town centre is in many ways unique when it comes to the concentration of service.

Within a radius of approximately 500 m there are shops, offices, banks, a hospital, schools, and a post office. Few Norwegian municipalities the size of Tynset can boast of two sport halls, a swimming pool and a health and training centre in the same complex.

Tynset Hall of Culture plays a vital role in cultural life in Tynset and the surrounding region.

Here you will find a library, art gallery, cinema, concert hall and theatre, meeting and conference room and a café. In the next few years the National Health Archive and a central depository will be established in Tynset bringing around 70 new jobs.

Tynset is known for its vast areas of forest and mountain, which are ideal for skiing, walking, cycling, hunting, and fishing. In many areas ski tracks are ploughed in wintertime. Tynset can be proud of being one of those municipalities that has many of its mountain farms (*seter*) still in use. It is possible to visit such farms when out hiking, which proves to be a valuable experience both for children and adults.
